Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) presented the Borough of Woodbine and its staff with certificates of achievement in three areas, as well as awarding the Borough \$1,700 as a “Gold Qualifier”.

The first certificate was in recognition of outstanding performance by employees and volunteers of the Borough whose safety efforts resulted in zero “lost time” accidents in 2008.

The second was in recognition of outstanding performance by employees and volunteers of the Borough whose loss ratio average from 2005-2007 beat the JIF's three-year loss ratio average.

The third was in recognition of Outstanding Performance by the employees of the Borough whose efforts resulted in Outstanding Claims reporting in 2008.

The \$1,700 awarded to the Borough as a Gold Qualifier will be used for purchase to further enhance the safety program.
