WOODBINE TO RECEIVE BIDS FOR COMMUNITY CENTER SENIOR ADDITION

Woodbine – Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine is advertising for bids to be opened on February 1, 2012, at 10 a.m. to construct a Senior Citizen Addition to the Community Center along with related renovations. The project is being funded under a New Jersey Department of Community Affairs Small Cities Public Facilities grant.

The scope of this project is construction of a 600 sq ft addition to the present Community Center to be dedicated to Senior Citizen activities. The Cape May County Department on Aging will be providing a nutrition program at the site once certified. Other renovations include ADA compliant restrooms.

This addition will allow expanded senior activities in a dedicated space. Among the planned activities, provided through the Woodbine Recreation Commission, are sewing and other arts and crafts, speakers on issues of interest to seniors, classes and training, etc.

“We once again thank DCA for this funding which will permit us to upgrade our Community Center facilities so as to allow us to expand our services and programs for our senior citizen component of our community without conflicting with other present activities also scheduled at the Center,” added Mayor Pikolycky.
