

**§ 5-1A. FEEDING OF WILD ANIMALS AND/OR STRAY ANIMALS; FREE ROAMING CATS; ABANDONMENT OF ANIMALS.**

**§ 5-1A.1. Feeding Wild and/or Stray Domestic Animals Restricted. [Ord. No. 521-2010 § 1]**

- a. Except as provided in Section 5-1B of this chapter, no person shall attract or feed wild and/or stray domestic animals, including but not limited to stray cats; stray dogs; seagulls; Canada geese or skunks within the Borough of Woodbine. Nothing contained herein shall prohibit persons from feeding birds on their private property using bird feeders or other similar receptacles. This section shall not apply to an Animal Control Officer in the performance of his/her official duties or to State and/or Federal wildlife officials in the performance of their official duties.
- b. No person shall allow any cat to roam free within the Borough of Woodbine in a manner to enter upon any area of the Borough designated by State or Federal agencies as areas reserved for protected or endangered species of birds or other wildlife.
- c. No person shall abandon any animal within the Borough of Woodbine.

**§ 5-1A.2. Violations and Penalties. [Ord. No. 521-2010 § 1]**

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable for a penalty in accordance with Section 1-5 et seq., of the Code of the Borough of Woodbine.
